INTRODUCTION

Manhattan Beach Chamber of Commerce Foundation (MBCC) is a member organization with a mission to promote the economic growth and development of small businesses. The Chamber has approximately 737 members, with 90% of its membership made up of small businesses. MBCC was recently asked to partner with the City Council on an entrepreneurial program to help support its local businesses.

The proposed training program will enhance the competitive position of small business owners and will provide sufficient computer and business skills to successfully manage and grow their businesses to a higher level of financial success.

MBCC is eligible to provide training as a group of employers for ETP funding as outlined under Title 22, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 4400(j)(3). Small business owners/entrepreneurs will be trained using Special Employment Training funds, Title 22, CCR, Section 4409(c).
