INTRODUCTION

American Airframe, Inc. dba Pacific Airframe and Engineering (AAI) was founded in 2001. The company manufactures spare aircraft parts and equipment such as fuel tanks, interior and exterior lighting, windshield wipers, and hydraulic systems.

AAI qualifies for standard ETP funding as a manufacturer facing out-of-state competition under Title 22, California Code of Regulations, Section 4416 (i) (2).

The company’s representative states ETP funds will assist the company to deliver formalized training to its workforce for the first time. The proposed training will allow the company to upgrade employee job skills in new software systems, promote company growth, and help workers become more proficient in the use of automated business solutions.
